"AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 13 OF ACT 939 OF 1987 WHICH IS THE
NON-SEVERABILITY PROVISION OF THE GAME AND FISH COMMISSION'S
APPROPRIATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 13 of Act 939 of 1987 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that Section 13 of Act 939 of 1987 provides that if any provision of the Game and Fish Commission's appropriation act is declared invalid then all provisions of the Act are invalid; that litigation is in process to invalidate one or more provisions of the Game and Fish Commission's appropriation; that unless the non-severability clause is eliminated, the entire appropriation for the Game and Fish Commission is in jeopardy; and that this Act repeals the non-severability clause and thereby makes the provisions of the appropriation act severable under Arkansas Statute 1-207. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
