HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING DEPARTMENT HEADS TO DIRECT OPERATORS OF STATE VEHICLES TO USE SELF-SERVICE PUMPS IN PURCHASING FUEL FOR STATE VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas is experiencing a financial crisis and every effort should be made to reduce the cost of governmental services and programs; and

WHEREAS, many State-owned vehicles are used by the various agencies of the State in conducting the business of the State and fuel cost is a substantial portion of the cost of operating such vehicles; and

WHEREAS, a substantial savings in fuel cost could be effected by the adoption of a policy that fuel for State vehicles be purchased at self-service pumps.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS.

SECTION 1. The House of Representatives hereby requests each State agency which operates one or more State-owned motor vehicles to adopt a policy requiring the operators of such vehicles to purchase fuel for such vehicles from self-service fuel pumps when possible, and to thereby reduce the cost of fuel used in such vehicles.

SECTION 2. Upon adoption of this Resolution, the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall transmit a copy hereof to each State agency, institution, board, commission and office which utilizes any State-owned motor vehicles.□
