

SENATE RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING THE CONSENSUS OF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE THAT UPON CONCLUSION OF THE BUSINESS OF THIS SPECIAL SESSION, THE SENATE WILL, PRIOR TO THE SINE DIE ADJOURNMENT, CONSIDER SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 3 WHICH WILL EXTEND THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING A BILL TO PROVIDE FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE STATE FROM THE CENTRAL INTERSTATE LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE COMPACT AND WHICH WOULD CREATE WITHIN THIS STATE AN ARKANSAS LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, S.C.R. 3 provides for the extension of the First Extraordinary Session of the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly to permit the consideration of Senate Bill 40 which provides for the termination of the State's participation in the Central Interstate Low-Level Radioactive Waste Compact and creates the Arkansas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Authority; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 6, Section 19 of the Arkansas Constitution, the General Assembly may, by a two-thirds vote of the members elected to each House, and upon conclusion of business in the manner set forth in the Governor's Proclamation convening the Special Session, provide for the extension of the Special Session for the purpose of considering other matters not in the Governor's Call;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That, by the adoption of this Resolution, it is the consensus of a majority of the members of the Senate, that upon conclusion of consideration of the items of business set forth in the Governor's Proclamation by which the First Extraordinary Session of the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly was convened, and prior to adjournment sine die, the Senate shall proceed to consider S.C.R. 3 for such action as the Senate may determine appropriate, and conclude said action prior to sine die adjournment of the Senate of this Extraordinary Session.
