HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROVIDING THAT THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, HAVING COMPLETED ACTION ON THE ITEMS IN THE GOVERNOR'S CALL, SHALL BE EXTENDED FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING OTHER LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS AS AUTHORIZED IN SECTION 19 OF ARTICLE 6 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THIS STATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE SENATE, TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO BOTH HOUSES AGREEING THERETO:

SECTION 1. That the Second Extraordinary Session of the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly has completed action deemed to be necessary with respect to items of business in the Proclamation of the Governor by which this Special Session was convened.

SECTION 2. That the Second Extraordinary Session of the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly of the State of Arkansas is hereby extended, pursuant to authority of Section 19 of Article 6 of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and shall remain in session for the transaction of other legislative business for such period of time as may be deemed necessary by both Houses of the General Assembly.
