HOUSE BILL 1006

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A TRANSFER OF MONIES FOR MATCHING FEDERAL FUNDS AS WELL AS ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE ARKANSAS GAME AND FISH COMMISSION IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE HOLLAND BOTTOMS PROPERTY; AND TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR MATCHING FUNDS OF THE ARKANSAS GAME AND FISH COMMISSION IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE HOLLAND BOTTOMS PROPERTY FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1989; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer the sum of one hundred twenty five thousand dollars (\$125,000) from the 76th Session Projects Account of the General Improvement Fund to the Game Protection Fund of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission for matching federal funds as well as any available funds of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission in order to provide improvements to the Holland Bottoms property.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated to the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, to be payable from the Game Protection Fund for Matching Funds of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission to be used to provide improvements to the Holland Bottoms property, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the sum of.....\$125,000.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, meeting in Third Extraordinary Session, that in order to access federal funds for making necessary improvements to the Holland Bottoms property so that the property will be more accessible to

handicapped and elderly citizens of Arkansas, State matching funds are needed. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
