HOUSE BILL 1041

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE ARKANSAS STRATEGIC PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1989; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas Strategic Planning Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988, and ending June 30, 1989, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Strategic Planning Commission, to be payable from the State General Services Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Strategic Planning Commission for the fiscal year ending

June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 3. On the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer shall cause to be transferred on his books, and the books of the State Auditor and State Treasurer, funds equal to the total amount apropriated in Section 2 of this Act. Such funds shall be transferred from the 76th Session Projects Account of the General Improvement Fund to the State General Services Fund Account and are to be used solely for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Strategic Planning Commission.

SECTION 4. The Director of the Arkansas Strategic Planning Commission shall be the disbursing officer for the funds appropriated by this Act.

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly meeting in the 3rd Extraordinary Session, that presently no comprehensive strategic plan for meeting the State's future needs exists and that this Act is necessary to allow the Arkansas Strategic Planning Commission to assess the needs of the State and formulate such a plan. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1988.
