

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT BY
ENACTING ACT 717 OF 1987 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY DID NOT INTEND
THAT COUNTY EMPLOYEES WHO RETIRED UNDER ACT 717 SHOULD BE
PRECLUDED FROM SEEKING THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE OF THE PEACE.

WHEREAS, Act 717 of 1987 provided incentives for county employees to
retire from county employment; and

WHEREAS, that Act is being construed as prohibiting a county employee
who retired under Act 717 from seeking the office of justice of the peace; and

WHEREAS, that was not the intent of the General Assembly,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY MEETING IN THIRD EXTRAORDINARY SESSION, THE SENATE CONCURRING
THEREIN:

That it was not the intent of the General Assembly by enacting Act 717
of 1987 to prohibit county employees who retired under that Act from seeking
the office of justice of the peace.
