

SENATE MEMORIAL RESOLUTION

IN RESPECTFUL MEMORY OF MR. MILTON S. SMITH III, AND IN
RECOGNITION OF HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND
TO HIS LOCAL COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, Mr. Milton S. Smith III, of Pine Bluff, Arkansas, died on Friday July 8, 1988, at the age of sixty years; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Smith, the brother of Arkansas State University President, Dr. Eugene Smith, was a retired Arkansas Department of Highway and Transportation District Engineer for the cities of Pine Bluff and Paragould; and
