For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAULING OF COUNTY GRAVEL BY PERSONS
OTHER THAN COUNTY EMPLOYEES; TO IMPOSE CRIMINAL PENALTIES;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) When any person other than a county employee hauls gravel for the county, the person shall list the location to which the gravel is delivered and the date on the invoice or receipt for the load of gravel.

(b) Any person who knowingly fails to comply with this section, or who knowingly provides false or misleading information for the purpose of concealing the delivery of county gravel for use on private property, or for the purpose of concealing a delivery that is in violation of county policy or state law shall be guilty of a Class D felony.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
