For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REPEAL THE TEXARKANA INCOME TAX EXEMPTION AND  
THE ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT SALES TAX EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1,  
1990."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) Effective January 1, 1990, Arkansas Code Sections  
26-52-601 through 606 are hereby repealed.

(b) All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby  
repealed.

SECTION 2. It is the intent of this Act to repeal the Texarkana  
income tax exemption for all income years beginning on and after January 1,  
1990, and to repeal effective January 1, 1990 the one percent (1%) sales  
tax levied in Texarkana in lieu of the State income tax.
