For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE A POSTING PROCEDURE FOR MULTI-FAMILY  
RESIDENTIAL AREAS AND BUSINESSES; TO PROHIBIT SOLICITATION  
THEREON; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) Any person owning or operating a mobile home park, apartment complex, recreational facility, multi-family residential facility or business may post the property by placing signs at each entrance to the grounds or premises which shall be at least twenty-four inches by twenty-four inches (24" x 24") and which indicate that no solicitation of any type is permitted upon the property.

(b) It is unlawful for any person to solicit upon any property posted under this act without the consent in writing of the owner or the owner's agent.

(c) Any person violating this act shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
