For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-22-103 TO PROVIDE THAT ANYONE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THIS STATE WITHOUT MINIMUM LIABILITY COVERAGE SHALL BE FINED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) AND IMPRISONED FOR THREE (3) DAYS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-22-103 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"27-22-103. Penalty. Any person who operates a motor vehicle within this state in violation of this chapter shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and imprisoned for not less than three (3) days, and driving privileges shall be suspended for one (1) year. Any person convicted of the second offense shall be fined not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) and/or imprisoned not less than three (3) days nor more than ninety (90) days, and the person's driving privileges shall be revoked for three (3) years. The court shall not have any discretion with reference to driving privilege suspension."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
