For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT POLICE CHIEFS OF EVERY FIRST CLASS CITY AND SECOND CLASS CITY SHALL EARN RETIREMENT CREDIT OF TWO (2) YEARS SERVICE FOR EVERY ONE (1) YEAR ACTUALLY SERVED AS CHIEF OF POLICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) Chiefs of police of every first class city and second class city shall earn two (2) years of retirement credit for every one (1) year actually served as chief of police. The age of eligibility for retirement benefits and all other applicable benefits shall remain the same depending upon the retirement program in which the individual is enrolled.

(b) This act shall be applicable to those serving as chief of police on or before the effective date of this act as well as those hired to serve as chief of police after the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
