For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 23-1-101 TO REDEFINE THE TERM  
'PUBLIC UTILITY'; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-1-101 (4) (D) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(D) The term 'public utility', as to any public utility defined in subdivision (4) (A) (iii) of this section, shall not include any person or corporation who or which:

(i) Furnishes the services exclusively to himself or itself, or to employees; or

(ii) Furnishes the services to persons who are temporary residents or guests in a hotel or motel owned by him or it; patients in a hospital owned by him or it; or students of a public or private institution of higher learning who reside in housing provided by that institution;".

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
