For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION TO ANNEX
TWELVE (12) LINEAL MILES OF COUNTY ROADS IN EACH COUNTY TO
THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM BY JULY 1, 1989; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The State Highway Commission is hereby authorized and directed to annex a minimum of ten (10) or a maximum of twelve (12) lineal miles of county roads in each county to the State Highway System by July 1, 1989. The beginning and end of each section added shall be connecting to an existing State Highway.

SECTION 2. After consultation with the State Highway Commission and no later than June 1, 1989, each county judge shall file with the Commission a written designation of the county roads which they desire to be added to the State Highway System. The sum of the roads in each County added to the System during this session of the Legislature shall be reduced in length to the maximum allowed under this Act.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. It has been found and is declared by the General Assembly of the

State of Arkansas that there is an urgent need for the annexation of certain county roads to the State Highway System and that the enactment of this Act will provide for more efficient operation and maintenance of said roads for the use and benefit of the citizens of the counties of this State; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Act, being necessary for the public peace, health and safety, shall take effect and be in force and effect from and after its passage.
