For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 2-40-207 TO PERMIT THE LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY COMMISSION TO CHARGE A FEE OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) PER HEAD FOR ON-THE-FARM VACCINATION OF CALVES ONLY IF IT DETERMINES THAT SUCH FEE IS NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN THE ON-THE-FARM CALFHOOD VACCINATION PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 2-40-207 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"2-40-207. The costs of on-the-farm calfhood vaccination shall be paid from state or federal funds. Provided, the Livestock and Poultry Commission may charge a fee of not to exceed one dollar (\$1.00) per head for on-the-farm calfhood vaccinations if it determines that such charge is necessary to provide necessary funds to enable it to maintain the on-the-farm calfhood vaccination program."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
