For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION 1(b) OF ACT 24 OF 1988 FOURTH EXTRAORDINARY SESSION TO LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF FEES AND PENALTIES CHARGED BY THE STATE PLANT BOARD TO REGULATE AND SUPERVISE THE MANUFACTURED SALE OF 100 PERCENT (100%) NATURAL ORGANIC FERTILIZER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection 1(b) of Act 24 of 1988 Fourth Extraordinary Session is amended to read as follows:

"(b) The State Plant Board shall have the authority to regulate and supervise the manufacture and sale of 100 percent natural organic fertilizer, including the setting and collecting of reasonable fees for sampling and analyzing the fertilizer and registering manufacturers, and shall adopt and promulgate such rules, regulations and penalties consistent with this act, and Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated §2-19-202, as may be necessary. The fees and penalties set and collected by the State Plant Board pursuant to this subsection shall not exceed like fees and penalties set for other types of fertilizers."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
