For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNOR'S TASK FORCE ON VETERANS' AFFAIRS TO ATTEND NATIONAL CONFERENCES OR MEETINGS OF RECOGNIZED VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS AND TO BE REIMBURSED FOR TRAVEL EXPENSES INCURRED IN ATTENDING SUCH CONVENTIONS, CONFERENCES AND MEETINGS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) PER YEAR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Each member of the Governor's Task Force on Veterans' Affairs is hereby authorized to attend conferences or meetings of recognized veterans organizations, and shall be entitled to reimbursement for expenses incurred in attending such meetings in an amount not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) per year. Such reimbursement shall be made by the Department of Veterans' Affairs from any funds available for such purposes and in accordance with laws and regulations regarding travel by state employees. A recognized veteran's organization is one listed in the Veterans' Administration Directory of Veterans' Organizations as meeting the criteria established in Section 14.628 of Title 38 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
