For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-14-601, SUBDIVISION
(a) (3) (I) (i) (a) (3) TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPTIONAL PURCHASE OF
PERMANENT REGISTRATION FOR COMMERCIAL SEMITRAILERS; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subdivision (a) (3) (I) (i) (a) (3) of Arkansas Code 27-14-601 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(3) All semitrailers used in combination with Classes Two through Eight trucks, a fee of thirteen dollars (\$13.00), provided, however, the owner of any semitrailer used in combination with Classes Two through Eight trucks may, at his option, pay a fee of sixty five dollars (\$65.00) for issuance of a permanent registration that shall remain valid, without annual renewal, until he sells or otherwise disposes of the semitrailer for which such registration is issued, and permanent registrations issued under this provision shall not be transferred to other owners or other vehicles, and shall not be replaced under the provisions of, Ark. Code Ann. §27-14-602(b) (6);"

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the State is in serious danger of losing revenues which are necessary to provide adequate funding for essential

service required by the citizens of this State and that the provisions of this act are necessary to avoid a substantial reduction in State revenues. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1989.
