For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT PETITIONS FOR INITIATED ACTS OR
INITIATED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS MUST BE FILED WITH THE
SECRETARY OF STATE FOR PUBLIC DISSEMINATION; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. In order to be readily available to the public, every petition for an initiated act or an initiated constitutional amendment shall be filed with the Secretary of State no later than ten (10) business days after the petition has been approved by the Attorney General.

SECTION 2. Every person who files a petition for an initiated act or an initiated constitutional amendment with the Attorney General shall be responsible for complying with this Act, and shall be subject to a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each day he violates this Act.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
