For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ALLOW CLASSROOM ENROLLMENT IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS
TO EXCEED THE STATE CLASSROOM SIZE STANDARDS BY UP TO
TEN PERCENT (10%) FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED TWO (2)
YEARS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The classroom enrollment in the public elementary and secondary schools of this State may exceed, on a classroom by classroom basis, by no more than ten percent (10%) for a period not to exceed two (2) years the maximum number of students per class prescribed by the State minimum standards. No public elementary or secondary school shall be decertified, issued warning letters, or otherwise penalized for exceeding the maximum number of students per class when authorized to do so under this Act.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
