For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE DISPENSING OF  
CONTRACEPTIVES ON THE PREMISES OF ANY ELEMENTARY OR  
SECONDARY SCHOOL SHALL BE PROHIBITED; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the Arkansas Family Planning Act or any other similar laws, no contraceptives, which are those items designed to prevent conception through chemical, mechanical, or other means, shall be dispensed upon the premises of any public elementary or secondary school.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
