For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO MAKE DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS AND OTHER
JUDICIAL DISTRICT PERSONNEL STATE EMPLOYEES; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated §16-21-113(g) is amended to read as follows:

"(g) All deputy prosecuting attorneys and other personnel under the jurisdiction of every judicial district prosecutor, shall be employees of the State of Arkansas effective July 1, 1990, and shall receive compensation from state funds appropriated by the General Assembly in amounts and in the same manner as is now provided by law. All deputies and judicial district employees covered by this act shall remain subject to removal at any time by the prosecuting attorney appointing them."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
