For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE STATE TO ASSUME COSTS OF
COURTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Effective January 1, 1990, the operating expenses accruing in the various courts, offices and functions under their jurisdiction, having original, limited and general jurisdiction, including but not limited to, circuit courts, chancery courts, probate courts, and juvenile paternity courts, or any separate division thereof, or any court of original, limited or general jurisdiction established subsequent to this act, shall be paid for by the state. The expenses shall include but not be limited to all personnel and office supply costs. The counties shall continue to provide courtrooms, office space, furnishings, utilities, and other expenses connected with the court facilities.

SECTION 2. Following the effective date of this act, all revenues generated by the courts and related functions subject to this act, shall be remitted to the State Treasurer.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
