For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE QUORUM COURT OF COUNTIES HAVING A POPULATION OF BETWEEN TWENTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND TWENTY THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED ACCORDING TO THE 1980 FEDERAL CENSUS TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL COURT COST NOT TO EXCEED FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) ON ALL CRIMINAL CASES FILED WITHIN SAID COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The quorum court of any county having a population of no less than twenty thousand two hundred (20,200) inhabitants nor more than twenty thousand six hundred (20,600) inhabitants according to the 1980 Federal Census of the population is hereby authorized to levy an additional court cost not to exceed five dollars (\$5.00) on each and every criminal case filed in any court within said county, provided that the levy of such additional court costs is approved by the county quorum court and the governing body of the largest first class city within said county. The funds derived from the additional court costs shall be deposited in the county treasury and shall be used exclusively for the payment of the salary and expenses of a juvenile officer, family court intake officer, if established, and/or juvenile probation officer, or any combination thereof.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
