"AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 17, CHAPTER 25, SUBCHAPTER 3 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987 TO REQUIRE LICENSURE OF ELECTRICIANS WITH TEN YEARS PRIOR EXPERIENCE IN ANOTHER STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-25-306 is hereby amended to read as follows:

" 17-25-306. Reciprocity.

The board shall be authorized to issue master and journeyman electrician's licenses to those applicants holding equivalent licenses in other states, or to issue a master electrician's license to those applicants who have ten years experience in another state which does not license electricians upon payment of the required fees and submission of proof of license or work experience in that state, provided in state issuing licenses that an agreement has been reached with that state to recognize the electrical licenses held by Arkansas residents."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
