For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REPEAL ARK. CODE ANN. §7-7-103(a); TO AMEND ARK. CODE ANN. §7-7-103(b) TO PROVIDE THAT INDEPENDENT CANDIDATES SHALL FILE THE PETITION FOR NOMINATION NO LATER THAN THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER THE GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Ark. Code Ann. §7-7-103(a) is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Ark. Code Ann. §7-7-103(b) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(b) Any person desiring to have his name placed upon the ballot as an independent candidate without political party affiliation for any state, county, township, or district office in any general election in this state shall file the petition for nomination as an independent candidate in the manner provided by in this section no later than thirty (30) days after the general primary election."

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
