For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO DESIGNATE AN ADDITIONAL PORTION OF U.S. HIGHWAY 71
AS A PART OF THE JOHN PAUL HAMMERSCHMIDT HIGHWAY; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

WHEREAS, Act 6 of 1989 designates that portion of U.S. Highway 71 from
its intersection with I-40 north to the Missouri line as the John Paul
Hammerschmidt Highway; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that an additional segment of U.S. Highway 71
be designated a part of the John Paul Hammerschmidt Highway,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. In addition to that portion of U.S. Highway 71 designated the
John Paul Hammerschmidt Highway by Act 6 of 1989, that portion of U.S. Highway
71 from its intersection with Interstate 540 in Fort Smith, Arkansas, to the
State Highway 10 exit near Greenwood, Arkansas, is hereby designated a part
of the John Paul Hammerschmidt Highway, and the State Highway and
Transportation Department shall erect appropriate signs along this section of
U.S. Highway 71 indicating that it has been designated the John Paul
Hammerschmidt Highway.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
hereby repealed.
