For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE PUBLIC DEFENDER IN THE COUNTIES HAVING A POPULATION OF FROM 30,800 TO 33,800, ACCORDING TO THE 1980 DECENNIAL CENSUS, TO EMPLOY AN INVESTIGATOR; TO AUTHORIZE THE ASSESSMENT BY THE COUNTY QUORUM COURT OF COURT COSTS TO FUND THE INVESTIGATOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) In any county having a population of from 30,800 to 33,800, according to the 1980 Decennial Census, the public defender may employ an investigator to help him in carrying out his duties.

(b) The quorum court in any such county may adopt an ordinance assessing additional court costs in order to provide funds for the payment of the said public defender's investigator, and the quorum court shall set the salary or the rate of pay for the said investigator.

(c) The investigator may be employed as an independent contractor or may be employed as an employee of the county at the discretion of the quorum court.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined that there is an immediate need for the public defender in certain counties to employ an investigator and that this act assists the counties in providing for an investigator. This act being necessary for the public peace, health, and

welfare, an emergency is declared to exist and this act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
