For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROHIBIT PURCHASES BY SCHOOL DISTRICTS FOR ITEMS AVAILABLE TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS UNDER STATE CONTRACT; TO SET THE MAXIMUM PRICE FOR PURCHASES OF CERTAIN COMMODITIES BY SCHOOL DISTRICTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) No school district commodity purchase may exceed the maximum price when purchasing any commodity available to school districts under purchase contract with the State of Arkansas.

(b) As used in this section, "maximum price" means the state contract price

of any commodity available to school districts under purchase contract with the State of Arkansas.

(c) No purchasing official shall parcel or split any item or items with the intent or purpose of avoiding the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
