For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT PERSONS UNDER SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE
MAY BE EMPLOYED IN A FILM OR VIDEO PRODUCTION AND SHALL NOT
BE REQUIRED TO BE ACCCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN NOR
TO OBTAIN AN EMPLOYMENT CERTIFICATE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF
LABOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Arkansas Code 11-6-106, Arkansas Code 11-6-109 or any other law to the contrary, persons under sixteen (16) years of age may be employed in films or other video productions in this State without being accompanied by their parent or guardian and without obtaining an employment certificate from the Arkansas Department of Labor or any other person or entity.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
