HOUSE BILL 1791

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A DECLARATION OF RESIDENCY FOR VOTING PURPOSES SHALL CREATE A PRESUMPTION OF RESIDENCY FOR ASSESSMENT OF PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of Arkansas Code 26-26-903, a declaration of residency for voting purposes shall create a rebuttable presumption of residency as it relates to the assessment of personal property.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
