For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 2-40-206 AND 207 TO ESTABLISH  
THE FEE FOR BRUCELLOSIS TESTING AND CALFHOOOD VACCINATION;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 2-40-206(a) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) The Livestock and Poultry Commission may assess a fee of not to exceed one dollar (\$1.00) for calfhood vaccination and brucellosis testing at the livestock auction markets. However, no fee shall be charged against any animal between the ages of four (4) months and twelve (12) months which has received a calfhood vaccination."

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 2-40-207 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"2-40-207. Costs of on-the-farm calfhood vaccinations. The costs of on-the-farm calfhood vaccination shall be paid from state or federal funds by the Livestock and Poultry Commission. Cattle owners may have on-the-farm calfhood vaccination performed by private veterinarians, and in such case the Livestock and Poultry Commission shall pay the veterinarian a reasonable fee for such service."

SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
