For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE COURT MAY REQUIRE PERSONS CONVICTED OF SEXUAL OFFENSES TO UNDERGO AN AIDS TEST AND ORDER THE RESULTS TO BE TRANSMITTED TO THE VICTIM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. When a person pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is found guilty of rape, incest or other sexual offense, the sentencing judge may order the offender to submit to a test for Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome and the judge may order the results of the test communicated to the victim.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
