For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAMES OF MUNICIPAL COURT, MUNICIPAL
JUDGE AND MUNICIPAL COURT CLERK; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The corporation courts in this state which are known as "municipal courts" shall hereafter be known and designated as "district courts". The judges of those courts shall hereafter be known and designated as "district judges" and the municipal court clerks of those courts shall be hereafter known and designated as "district court clerks."

SECTION 2. All code provisions of the state of Arkansas now in force which refer to "municipal court", "municipal judge", or "municipal court clerks" shall be construed to refer to "district court", "district judge" and "district court clerk" respectively.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
