For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-27-104(c)(1) TO CLARIFY
MONETARY ENTITLEMENTS OF THE BOARD OF CORRECTION."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-27-104(c)(1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(c)(1) Members of the Board of Correction shall be entitled to sixty dollars (\$60.00) per day for each day they shall be engaged in attending official board meetings or attending to Board of Correction business. In addition thereto, each member shall be entitled to receive actual meal and lodging expenses and mileage at the same rate authorized by the state travel regulations for state employees for each mile traveled in going to official meetings and business of the Board or Department of Correction from their place of residence or business and returning therefrom. The reimbursement for use of private airplanes shall be in accordance with state travel regulations."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the language of the current law relating to the per diem and expenses of the State Board of Correction for attending meetings of the board and other business of the board is in urgent need of clarification; that this act is designed to clarify the same and should be given effect immediately.

Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
