For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF SECRETARY-CASE
COORDINATORS OF THE EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT-EAST; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Each Circuit Judge, Chancery Judge, and Circuit/Chancery Judge, Eighteenth Judicial Circuit-East, may employ a secretary-case coordinator to serve each Judge at the pleasure of the appointing Judge, at an annual salary based upon the classification in the Table in Section 2 payable in equal monthly installments by Garland County.

SECTION 2. No payment of salary may be made except in conformity with the salary rates assigned in the Table below and only after the appointing judge has certified in writing the term of the employee's experience to the County Clerk:

<u>GRADE</u>	<u>EXPERIENCE</u>	<u>SALARY</u>
I	Entry Level	\$19,500.00
II	18 months	20,250.00
III	36 months	21,000.00

The appointing judge shall have discretion in certifying or omitting to certify increases in salary above the entry level.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the secretary-case coordinators of the several courts of the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit-East have varying experience and beginning in 1990, classifications in Section 2 should be implemented and is necessary to the

proper administration of justice.

SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
