For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SURVIVOR BENEFITS FOR CITY CLERKS AND  
TREASURERS UPON APPROVAL BY THE GOVERNING BOARD; TO PERMIT  
CURRENT RETIRANTS TO SELECT A SURVIVOR BENEFIT; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) Upon approval by the governing body, any city may provide for survivor benefits for any city clerk or treasurer who dies while in service.

(b) Any city clerk or treasurer already retired and pensioned, may petition the governing body which has established survivor benefits under this act to grant such benefits. Such petition must be made in writing to the governing board on or before July 1, 1991. Upon approval of the governing body, the pension benefit of the retirant shall be recalculated.

(c) Any provision for survivor benefits under this act shall be only after a determination by the governing body of the actuarial soundness of the fund from which the benefits shall be paid.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
