For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF EMPLOYERS  
AND EMPLOYEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. A person who requires by contract that another person comply with any state or federal law, regulation or rule, including but not limited to one relating to wages, benefits or safety conditions, shall not be deemed to subject that person to his control for purposes of determining agency.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
