For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT RELATING TO PORTIONS OF WATER SYSTEMS LYING WITHIN AN
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OR MUNICIPALITY AND OWNED BY ANOTHER
MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Any water improvement district or any municipality that has paid for the construction of water pipelines and other portions of the infrastructure of a water system used by the district or municipality and has dedicated the property to the use of another municipality shall be entitled to the return of the property located within its boundaries without charge by a vote of a majority of the board of directors of the water improvement district or the governing body of the municipality.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
