HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS TO REFRAIN FROM CLOSING
PARK FACILITIES IN ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, four of the Corps of Engineers parks on Greers Ferry Lake have been earmarked for partial or total closings this Fall; and

WHEREAS, since tourism is such an important part of the economy of this State, it is imperative that recreational facilities not be closed; and

WHEREAS, the closing of Corps of Engineers parks will have a significant negative economic impact on many citizens of this State,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the United States Army Corps of Engineers is hereby requested to refrain from closing any of its recreational facilities in this State.
