HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY FOR ITS NINETY-NINE
YEAR HISTORY OF SERVING THE PEOPLE OF THIS STATE.

WHEREAS, the institution now known as Henderson State University was founded March 24, 1890, through the joint efforts of the citizens of Arkadelphia, Arkansas, and the congregation of the local Methodist Episcopal Church;

WHEREAS, the institution was chartered on June 10, 1890, as a private, coeducational, baccalaureate degree-granting, liberal arts college; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 1929, during the Thirty-Ninth year of the institution then known as Henderson-Brown College, the Forty-Seventh General Assembly of the State of Arkansas passed Act 46 for the State of Arkansas to assume control and establish a Standard Teachers College at Henderson-Brown College; and

WHEREAS, Henderson has been in continuous service to the people of the great State of Arkansas since 1890 and has created excellent academic programs in the arts and sciences, education, business, and aviation,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly of the State of Arkansas takes great pleasure in commending and congratulating Henderson State University for its Ninety-Nine years of service to the people of Arkansas.
