HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO PERMIT THE INTRODUCTION OF A BILL PERTAINING TO
RECIPROCITY BETWEEN THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT
SYSTEM AND ANY LOCAL POLICE OR FIRE PENSION AND RELIEF FUND
FOR MEMBERS WITH PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE.

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code 10-2-115 provides that no retirement bill may be introduced after the first thirty (30) calendar days of a regular biennial session of the General Assembly except upon approval by a vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the full membership of each house of the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the first thirty (30) calendar days of the Seventy-Seventh (77th) General Assembly having expired,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT Representative Flanagin is hereby granted leave to introduce a bill relating to reciprocity between the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System and any local police and fire pension and relief fund for members with public safety service.
