HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO PERMIT THE INTRODUCTION OF A BILL PERTAINING TO SURVIVOR BENEFITS FOR CITY CLERKS AND TREASURERS UPON APPROVAL BY THE GOVERNING BOARD AND TO PERMIT CURRENT RETIRANTS TO SELECT A SURVIVOR BENEFIT.

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code 10-2-115 provides that no retirement bill may be introduced after the first thirty (30) calendar days of a regular biennial session of the General Assembly except upon approval by a vote of at least two-thirds (2/3rds) of the full membership of each house of the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the first thirty (30) calendar days of the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly having expired,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That Representative Flanagin is hereby granted leave to introduce a bill relating to survivor benefits for city clerks and treasurers upon approval by the governing board and to permit current retirants to select a survivor benefit.
