HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO CONTINUE THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON TOURISM DEVELOPMENT IN
IN ORDER TO ASSIST THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND TOURISM
IN ATTRACTING VISITORS TO OUR STATE AND IN DERIVING THE
MOST BENEFIT FROM THE REVENUES GENERATED BY THE TWO
PERCENT (2%) TOURISM TAX.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Subcommittee on Tourism Development of the Joint Interim
Committee on Agriculture and Economic Development be continued through the
next biennium. The Subcommittee shall assist the Department of Parks and
Tourism in attracting visitors to our State and otherwise promoting tourism in
Arkansas, and shall assist the Department in deriving the most benefit from the
revenues generated by the two percent (2%) tourism tax levied by the General
Assembly during the 1989 Regular Session. The committee shall consist of the
current members of the General Assembly who served during 1988 on the
Subcommittee on Tourism Development of the Joint Interim Committee on
Agriculture and Economic Development. In addition to those persons, the
subcommittee shall consist of five (5) additional members of the House to be
appointed by the Speaker and three (3) additional members of the Senate to be
appointed by the President Pro Tem. The chairman of the Tourism Development
Subcommittee shall be appointed by the co-chairmen of the Joint Interim
Committee on Agriculture and Economic Development.
