HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION AND THE ARKANSAS HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT STAFF FOR BEING RECOGNIZED AS HAVING THE LOWEST ADMINISTRATION COSTS IN THE NATION.

WHEREAS, recently published federal statistics report that the percentage of cost to administer highway and transportation programs in Arkansas is the lowest in the nation, and

WHEREAS, this record has been achieved by maintaining a level work force despite increasing construction programs and maintenance demands, and

WHEREAS, such low overhead costs provide more resources to build and maintain transportation facilities for the benefit of our citizens,
NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Arkansas Highway Commission and the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department are hereby commended for their efficient and effective operation in being recognized as having the lowest administration costs in the nation.
