HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE AND THE SENATE TO
ALLOW REPRESENTATIVE KEET TO INTRODUCE A PROPOSED
CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO ALLOW THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO
PLACE NO MORE THAN FIVE PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS
ON THE GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Joint Rules of the House and Senate are hereby suspended to
allow Representative Keet to introduce a proposed constitutional amendment
to allow the General Assembly to place no more than five (5) proposed
constitutional amendments on the general election ballot.
