HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULE OF THE HOUSE AND SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY REQUIRING THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS TO REPORT ITS RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS NO LATER THAN THE FIFTY-FIFTH DAY OF THE REGULAR SESSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Joint Rule of the House and Senate requiring the Joint Committee on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs to report its recommendations regarding proposed constitutional amendments no later than the fifty-fifth day of the Regular Session is hereby suspended and that the committee may report its recommendations at any time during this Regular Session.
