HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF ARKANSAS TRAVELER CERTIFICATES

WHEREAS, it is customary and appropriate for sovereign states to present a certificate of honor to distinguished visitors, citizens, and former citizens of the state who have distinguished themselves in business, politics, and the professions; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas has a title of honor which would be an appropriate and distinctive honorary title to such distinguished citizens, that of ARKANSAS TRAVELER;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Governor of the State of Arkansas be authorized to designate and appoint distinguished visitors, citizens, and former citizens, who have distinguished themselves in various fields of endeavor as an ARKANSAS TRAVELER.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that appropriate commissions be issued to such appointees, duly signed by the Governor and attested by the Secretary of State, and the Governor is hereby directed to issue such commissions upon appointment by the Governor and record same in a suitable book of records.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the nomination by members of the General Assembly of person qualified to receive this honorary title, the sponsors will be indicated on the face of the certificate with a space for sponsors' signatures.
