HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC RETIREMENT AND
SOCIAL SECURITY PROGRAMS TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF PENSION
BENEFITS FOR LEGISLATORS OF SISTER STATES.

WHEREAS, only through a thorough and detailed study of legislative retirement benefits of sister states can current benefits of this state be accurately evaluated and measured; and

WHEREAS, a study of pension benefits for legislators of sister states would assist the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs in evaluating any proposed legislation for changes in Arkansas benefits which may arise in the future; and

WHEREAS, the complexity of the study indicates that it should transpire between legislative sessions; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs is the appropriate committee to conduct such study,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That as soon as possible after the adjournment of this General Assembly the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs commence a study of the pension benefits for legislators of other states.
